Additionally, he is past president of the Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation, Inc., the 501(c)(3) affiliate of the Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation.

He is a member of the board of directors and treasurer of the Robins Foundation and served as counsel to the Virginia State Golf Association Foundation. Reggie was the first citizen member appointed to the Virginia Board of Medicine, was the founding president of the Henrico County Bar Association, was appointed to the Virginia Early Learning Council by Governor Warner and currently serves as Chairman of the board of directors of the Virginia Early Childhood Foundation.

He was named the *Best Lawyers®* Government Relations 'Lawyer of the Year' in Richmond in 2013 and 2016. In addition, he has been listed in *The Best Lawyers in America®* since 2007, and he was named among Virginia's 'Legal Elite' by *Virginia Business* magazine from 2008-2013.
