Ty was appointed by Governor Youngkin to serve on Virginia's Commonwealth Transportation Board in 2022 for a four-year term. The Commonwealth Transportation Board consists of 17 members appointed by the Governor. The Board oversees transportation projects and initiatives for the Commonwealth of Virginia.
